Overview and Vision of NATi

Applicant Eligibility

- 1. The Lead Investigator and Co-Investigators as defined in Grant Terms and Conditions should:
 - a. Hold a primary appointment in a Singapore publicly funded research institution or an institute of higher learning (IHL). The Lead Investigator must hold a primary appointment of at least 0.7 FTE in Singapore.
 - b. Lead a laboratory or research programme which carries out research in Singapore
 - c. Possess track record of leadership ability in coordinating research programmes and providing mentorship to research teams as well as having productive research outcomes. A track record in securing IRS will be advantageous.
- 2. Exceptions to the above eligibility criteria will be considered on a case-by-case basis. Please submit a request to the NATi Coordinating Office.
- 3. Collaborators as defined in Grant Terms and Conditions are not eligible to receive NATi funding. Companies can participate in NATi projects only as collaborators. There are no exceptions.

Up to S\$300K (incl. 30% indirect costs), max.12 months

Eligibility

Singapore Public Sector Researchers as defined in previous slide

Grant Period

Applications are accepted anytime until 30 Sep 2025, 12pm, Singapore Time

Grant Scope

Rapid preclinical development of an RNA vaccine or therapeutic in response to an ongoing disease outbreak

Key Requirements

- The outbreak should present a significant public health risk to Singapore
- The path to clinic should be identified upfront to facilitate a rapid response

Objectives of NATi T01 Call for Proposals

The NATi T01 Rolling Call for Proposals aims to develop an **RNA vaccine or therapeutic** in **rapid response to an outbreak** that presents a significant public health risk to Singapore.

Projects are expected to advance rapidly through collaboration with one or more NATi-funded platform and identify a clear path to the clinic.

Funding Quantum and Duration

Up to S\$5M (incl. 30% indirect costs), max. 36 months

Eligibility

Singapore Public Sector Researchers as defined in previous slide

Grant Period

Applications are accepted anytime until 30 Sep 2025, 12pm, Singapore Time

Grant Scope

Strategic research projects with industry that can help to accelerate the development and commercialisation of RNA drugs and RNA therapeutics-related technologies in Singapore

Key Requirements

- a) A Research Collaboration Agreement (RCA) with an industry partner should be in its final stages of negotiation and/or execution, pending NATi's funding
- b) Cash contributions from industry partner is required, and should match at least 50% of the total grant request. In-kind contributions will be taken into consideration during evaluation.

Objectives of NATi T02 Call for Proposals

The NATi T02 Call for Proposals aims **to foster industry collaborations** and **generate economic outcomes** for Singapore in the nucleic acid therapeutics sector.

Applicants are expected to collaborate on strategic research projects with an industry partner to accelerate the development and commercialisation of RNA drugs and RNA therapeutics-related technologies in Singapore.

- Evaluation will begin upon acknowledgement of receipt and results of the LOI will be communicated to the Lead Investigator within 2 – 3 weeks of LOI submission.
- Shortlisted applicants will be invited to submit a full written proposal
- Lead Investigator may be invited to present
- Outcome of review will be communicated to the Lead Investigator within 2 – 3 months of full proposal submission
- After final budget review, successful applicants will be issued In-Principle Approval and subsequently a Letter of Award.
