Upon completion of the Masters programme, scholars will return to Singapore and serve a two-year service commitment with A*STAR.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA[†]

- Open to Singaporeans
- ✓ Have obtained, or are on track to obtain, at least a 2nd Upper Class
 Honours Degree or equivalent in relevant disciplines
- Have strong interest in a research career
- ✓ Have applied or will be applying for a Masters of Research (or equivalent) programme at a top overseas university

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- 1. Does the scholarship support a Masters by Research programme only? A Masters programme with 50% of time committed to hands-on research is also considered.
- 2. I am currently holding a scholarship for my undergraduate studies from another government ministry/agency. Can I still apply for NSS (Masters)?

Please clarify the policy and guidelines with your sponsoring organisation before applying for an A*STAR scholarship.

3. Do I need to have secured a place in an overseas graduate school before applying for NSS (Masters)?

While it is not necessary to have secured a place in an overseas university prior to the scholarship application, you are required to show proof of application to one or more universities.

4. I have a few years of Research Officer experience in an A*STAR Research Institute. Will my scholarship application be considered favourably compared to a fresh graduate?

As these are national scholarships, all applications will be treated equitably and reviewed holistically based on criteria such as academic track record, publications and research exposure/experience. Your experience as a Research Officer will be beneficial as part of your overall portfolio for the scholarship application.

5. I do not have any prior experience in research, will there be guidance provided before I embark on my Masters studies?

Once awarded, NSS (Masters) scholars will be provided advice guidance by experienced researchers on academic, research, career and deployment matters.

6. Can I pursue a PhD immediately upon completion of my Masters programme?

As NSS (Masters) is designed to help meet accelerated demand in emerging areas of research, NSS (Masters) scholars are not eligible to further their studies and undertake a PhD programme upon the completion of their Master's programme.

NSS (Masters) scholars may, however, further their studies after serving the bond.
