

#### ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA<sup>†</sup>

- Open to all Singaporeans or Singapore Permanent Residents (SPR).
- ✓ Have completed a PhD within the last four years
- ✓ Possess excellent publication records
- No existing bond with any institution
- ✓ Have applied or applying for a relevant post-doctoral position at a top overseas university/laboratory

# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

#### 1. What is the application and interview process like?

You are required to submit your application and documents <u>online</u>. Only complete applications will be reviewed. Shortlisted applicants will be invited to attend at least 2 rounds of interviews and other test(s) where applicable.

Prior to the interviews, you are encouraged to think about the A\*STAR Research Institute (RI) where you will serve your 3-year bond after your post-doctoral training and how your post-doctoral training can help add value to the RI.

During the first round of interview, you will be given 30 minutes in total to present your proposed research project and answer questions on it.

2. Is there any criteria for the proposed overseas university/institution? The proposed overseas university/institution should be a leading institution in your proposed research area.

#### 3. Can I propose any research topic?

You should propose a research topic/area that is aligned to A\*STAR's research direction and of relevance and value to the A\*STAR Research Institutes. We strongly encourage you to have a discussion with the A\*STAR Research Institutes that is of interest to you before you propose a topic.

4. Do I have to serve a bond at A\*STAR after completing my post-doctoral training? How long is the service commitment period?

Upon completion of post-doctoral training under the AIF, you will serve at one of A\*STAR's Research Institute for three years.

5. Is it possible to change my research project midway through my post-doctoral training?

All scholars need to seek A\*STAR's written permission before changing your research project. Each case will be assessed on its own merit. However, scholars are encouraged to consider your research area seriously before commencing your post-doctoral studies as a mid-point change of your research focus may badly affect your progress.
