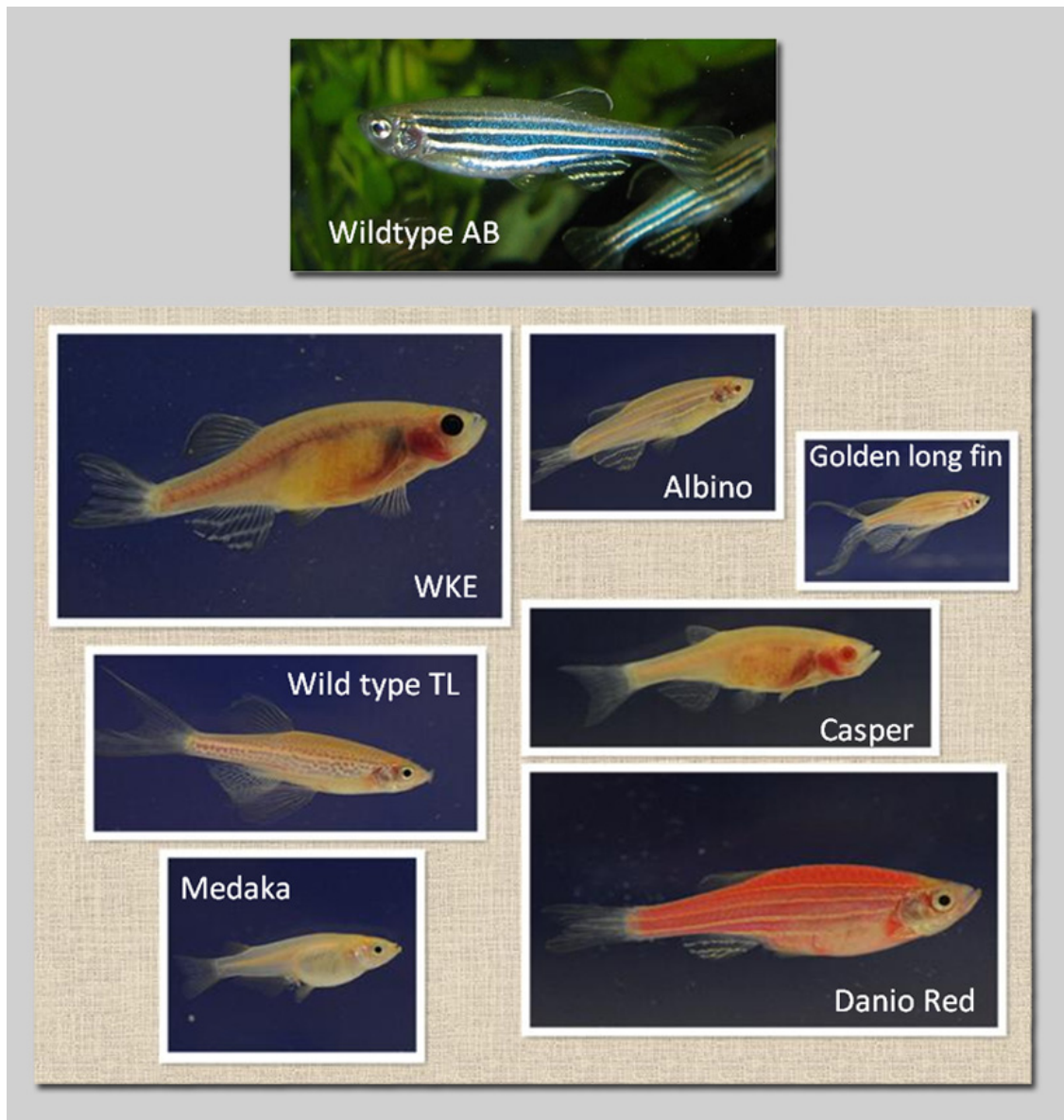

Zebrafish Charges w.e.f. December 2018.



The IMCB zebrafish facility is a national resource that is available for use by the burgeoning biomedical community in the country and the geographical region of South-East Asia. We offer a variety of services that include supply of adult fish and embryos, raising embryos to adulthood, maintenance of adult fish and rental of tank space for research purposes. Charges for these services are summarized below. In addition, we are now offering services for making mutant and transgenic strains of zebrafish using a variety of genome editing techniques (such as CRISPR/Cas9).
