An overview of entomological research at the Shoklo Malaria Research Unit

Mosquito-borne diseases cause significant burdens in rural Southeast Asia and have been the focus of the research carried out at the Entomology Department of the Shoklo Malaria Research Unit on the Thailand-Myanmar border since it was created in 2010. In this seminar, I will give an overview of research outputs in previous years and highlight some recent results of our investigations of mosquito biology and ecology, trials of vector-control and in vitro studies on vivax malaria parasites.

Dr Victor Chaumeau is heading the Entomology Department at the Shoklo Malaria Research Unit in Thailand since 2016. Before joining the SMRU, he earned his PharmD and PhD at the University of Montpellier by conducting operational research on the entomological aspects of malaria elimination on the Thailand-Myanmar border.
