Older Human B Cells and Antibody Class Switching

Professor Deborah Dunn-Walters is Professor of Immunology and Associate Dean for Research and Innovation in the Faculty of Health and Medical Sciences at the University of Surrey, UK. She is a Trustee of the British Society for Immunology and is the Chair of the Dunhill Medical Trust, a charity that supports research for healthy ageing.

A champion of interdisciplinary research, her group studies B cell development in Health and Disease, taking a systems immunology approach to elucidate changes in humoral immunity with age. Her lab develops improved tools to study immune repertoires, including novel methods for single cell analysis at a large scale and particularly as applied to elucidating the human immunological responses to infections and vaccines. She has over 100 peer reviewed research publications and has collaborated with many different laboratories worldwide, and has chaired several international B cell conferences.
