Professor Stephen Renshaw is the Sir Arthur Hall Professor of Medicine at the University of Sheffield, combining clinical work in respiratory medicine with research into the molecular controls of inflammation resolution and host-pathogen interaction.

Prof. Renshaw has a specialist interest in rare and complex interstitial lung diseases, and delivers acute respiratory care at Sheffield teaching Hospitals NHS Trust. His key research achievement is the development of innovative transgenic zebrafish models to aid understanding of innate immunity.
